Uncommon results from creating a breakthrough in causing and engaging their community.

Community: Groups that avoided working together started sharing and collaborating and raised over one million dollars towards community endeavours

New School: 10 year forecast capacity filled within 2 years requiring portables

RCMP: reported in 2 years Youth Crime charges dropped from 37 to 0

How was this possible in Bashaw?

How many can see these are shocking results: it's not common?

How this was possible was through a very unique methodology.

Bashaw went after their own mentality. They went after discovering their thinking. Instead of getting experts to find out, they looked at their shared thinking in town that caused their problems in the first place.

What does it look like to discover your own level of thinking ? /what they discovered is inside of 54 not for profits, inside of a town of 875 is, you won't listen, you won't care about myt ideas so now I'll wait you out tul you go or die and then I'll take over.

Discover the magic of owning and addressing the context



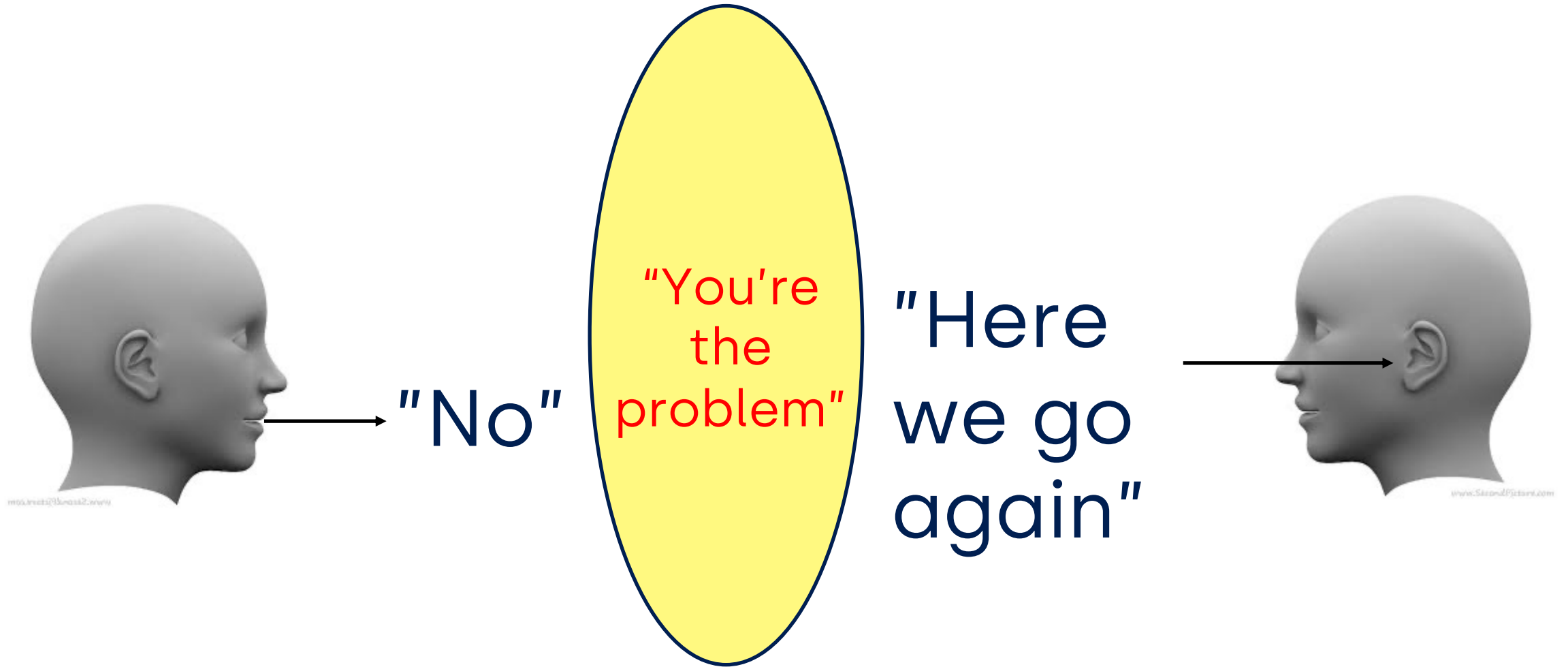
The Master Switch is Your Context

Listening for Commitment

1. **Content:** what they said, how they said it
2. **Experience:** emotion, What it's really like for them?
3. **Commitment:** what's deeply important, what's the future they're striving for?
