Did You Know? Grimshaw was named for Dr. M.E. Grimshaw, a pioneer doctor who established a practice in the village of Peace River Crossing in 1914, and gave loyal service to the settlers of the Peace River District for many years. He served on the village council for many years, and held the positions of Reeve, Village Commissioner, and later the position of Mayor from which he resigned in 1922.
