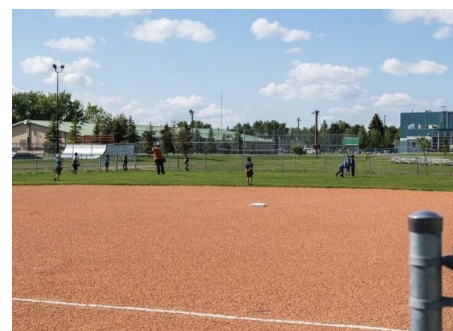

Hidden Gem! Bodo Archaeology society runs interpretive programming and tours at the Bodo Archaeological Site and Centre. Their mission is to promote public archaeology, education and conservation of historical and archaeological resources on site.

The tours and programs showcase fascinating archaeological sites unique to indigenous bison hunting camps of Canada's Plains indigenous groups and engage and educate the public by providing an authentic experience at an archaeological excavation. These programs also promote an understanding, awareness and appreciation of the discipline of archaeology and indigenous culture in what is now Alberta.

We would like to take this opportunity to acknowledge the traditional territories of the Indigenous peoples of the Treaty 6 region and the Métis Settlements and Métis Nation of Alberta, Regions 2, 3 and 4.
