Hidden Gem! Beaverhill Bird Observatory (BBO) – Located on the southeast corner of Beaverhill Lake, has been in operation since 1984 and is the second oldest migration monitoring observatory in Canada. Recognized as a wetland of international significance, this 'hotbed' for birding has reported more than 270 species of waterfowl, of which 145 are known to breed locally. The BBO area is a great place to visit and enjoy nature.
