Hidden Gem! Bassano, "Best in the West by a Dam Site" is a community of 1200 located on the TransCanada highway between Calgary and Medicine Hat. It serves a large rural area within the County of Newell and the adjacent Siksika Nation.

Positioned at the headwaters of the Eastern Irrigation District, the Bassano Dam (completed in the spring 1914) is a symbol of the foresight and engineering ingenuity of the early pioneers to create water reservoirs for irrigation, fishing, and water sports. The water level at the Bassano Dam can be raised 14 m (46 ft) above the riverbed, diverting water from the Bow River into the Eastern Irrigation District while maintaining constant waterflow downstream.
