Did You Know? Grande Cache is home of The Canadian Death Race - Since the start of the millennium, racers have come to the Canadian Rockies to cheat Death in one of the world's toughest ultramarathons. The 118km course begins and ends on a 4200-foot plateau, passes over three mountain summits, and not only includes over 17,000 feet of elevation change but a major river crossing at the spectacular Hell's Gate canyon at the confluence of the Smoky and Sulphur Rivers.

Hidden Gem! Wilmore Wilderness Park is our backyard - ancient glaciers, high mountain peaks, thick forests and raging rivers define these 4,597 square kms of untamed wilderness. Backpackers and horseback riders seeking true backcountry experience can explore over 750 km of trails where wildlife abounds. No motorized vehicles in the park and the entrance is just a short drive from Grande Cache by Sulfur Gates.
