




#### Population growth between census (2006-2011)


Population growth is not evenly distributed throughout Alberta.



# The need for physicians is influenced by each region's capacity to retain its physicians.

Some areas of Alberta face greater challenges when it comes to keeping physicians within their communities.



#### Physician per 100,000 Variation (2009-2014)

A region with strong population growth and a relatively lower retention figure can result in an overall decrease in the number of physicians available for each inhabitant, despite strong efforts geared towards attracting new physicians to the area.








### International Medical Graduates / Canadian Medical Graduates in Alberta: Rural vs Urban Practise (2014)




IMG physicians help fill the need for health care practitioners in those areas which face greater challenges in attracting Canadian medical graduates (CMG).


#### Percent of International Medical Graduates in Region (2014)
















Origin of 2015 Physician Cohort (Over 5 Years)
