Headcount Distribution Map

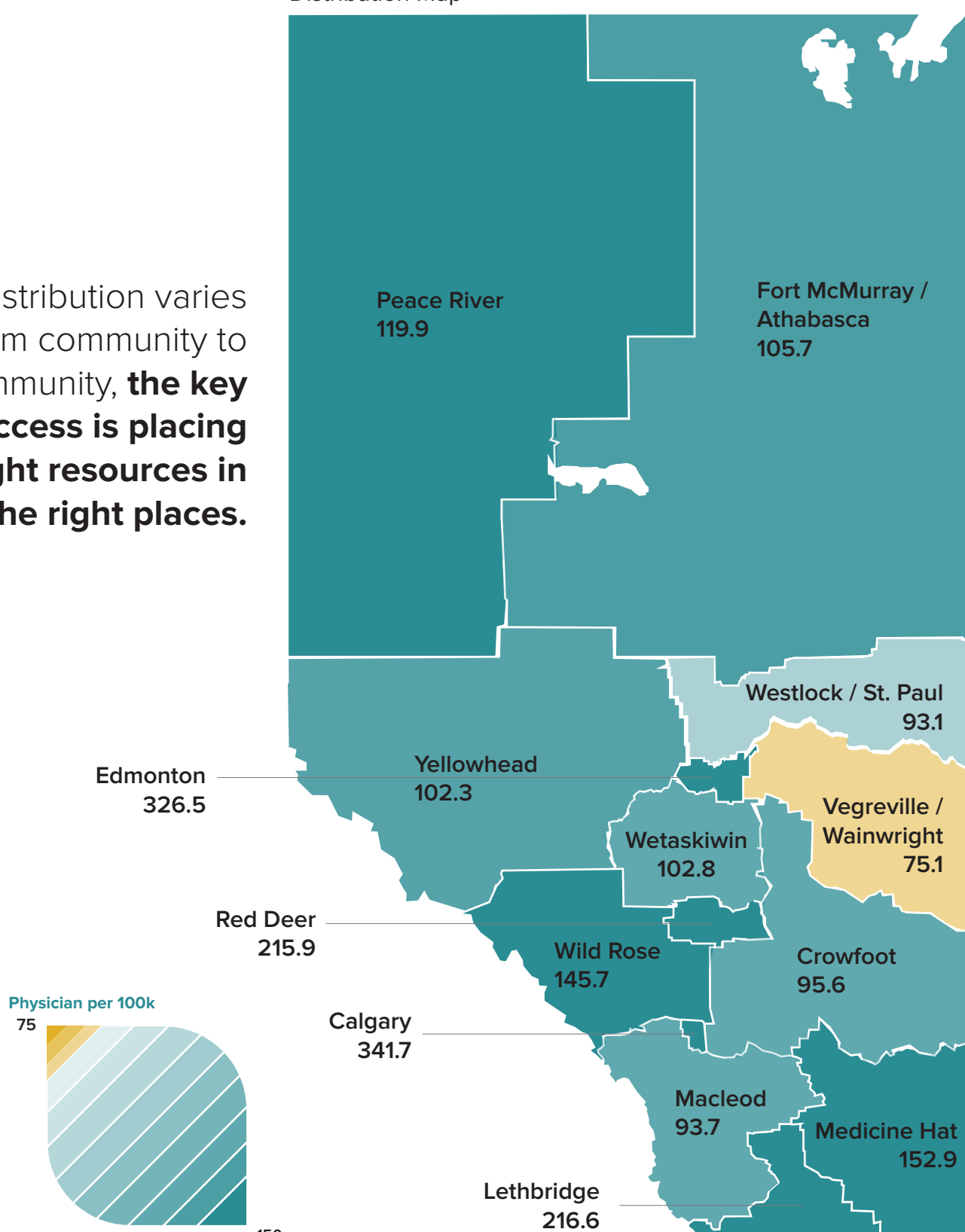
Quality healthcare exists outside of Edmonton and Calgary.
