

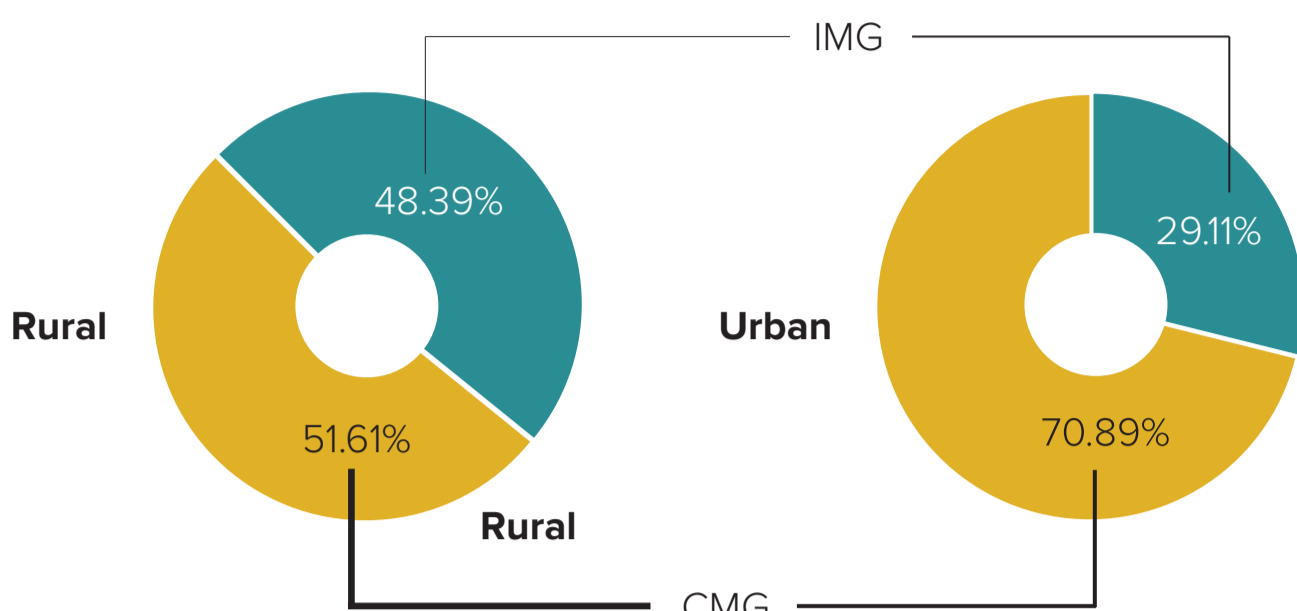


The landscape of healthcare in rural Alberta

International Medical Graduates

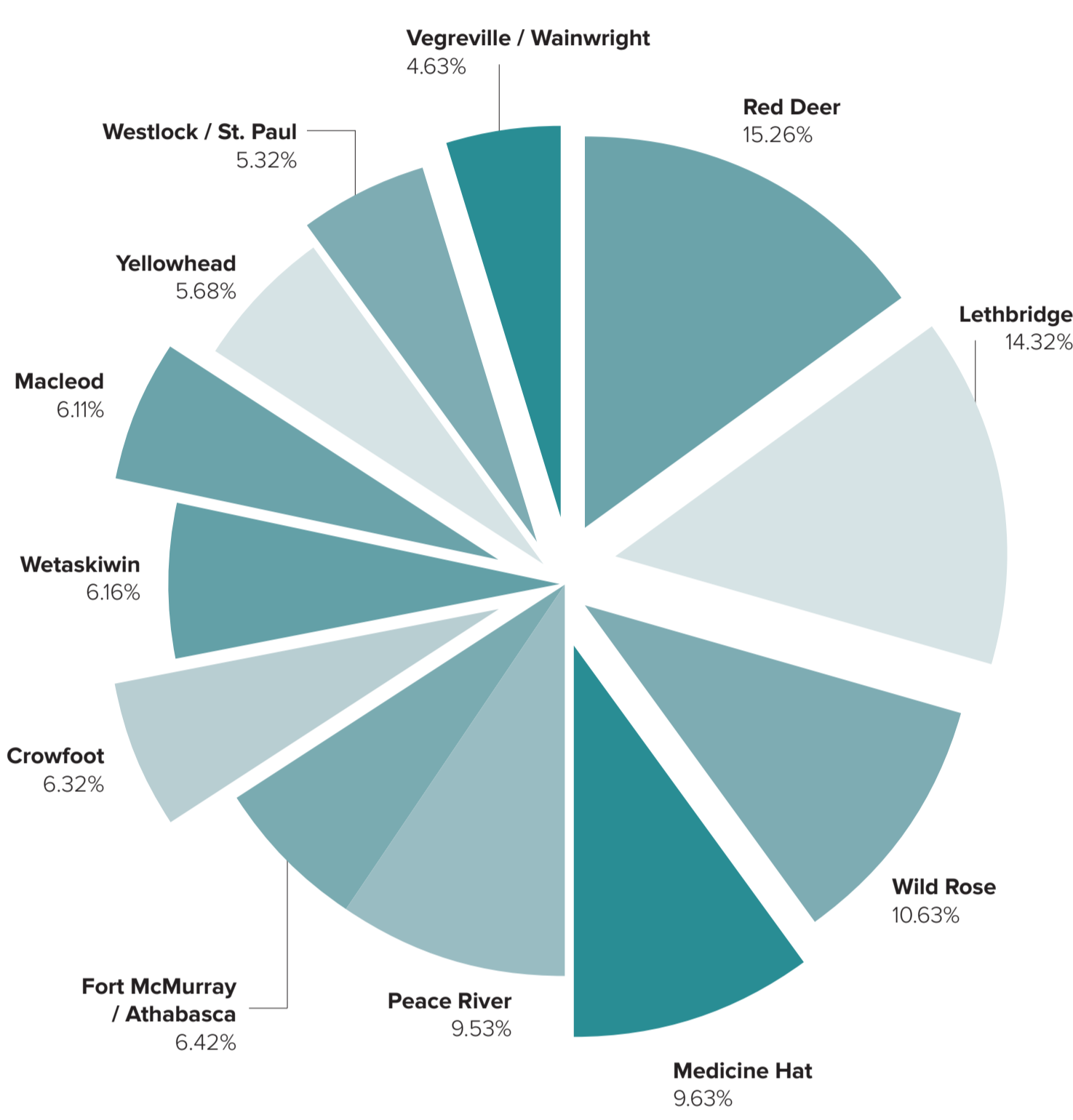

International Medical Graduates / Canadian Medical Graduates in Alberta: Rural vs Urban Practise (2014)

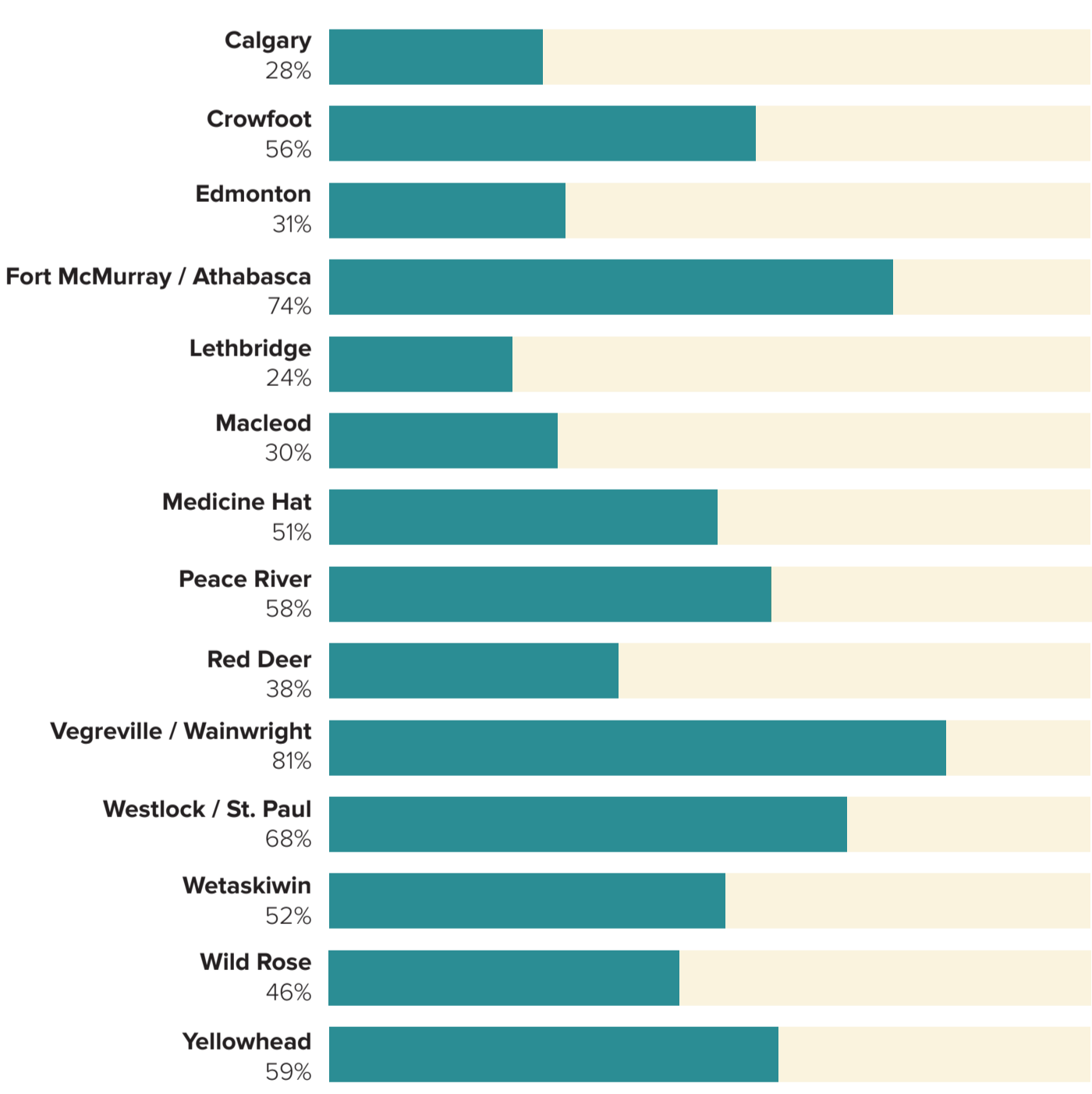


IMG physicians help fill the need for health care practitioners in those areas which face greater challenges in attracting Canadian medical graduates (CMG).

Location of International Medical Graduates in Alberta (2014)

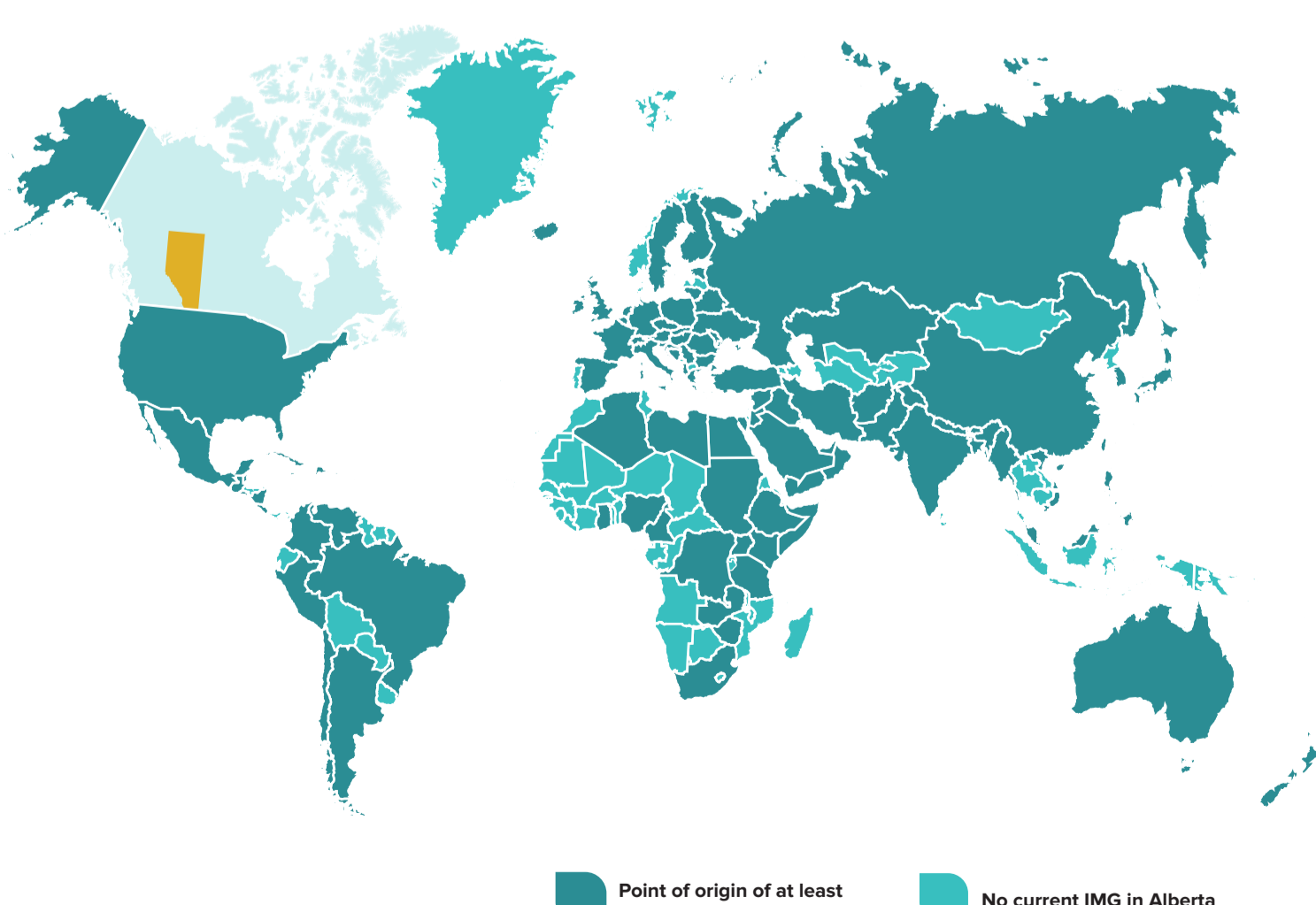


Percent of International Medical Graduates in Region (2014)
